Please read the following instructions and conditions carefully:

1. Entries are open to Film & Media students from all local universities and TAFE Colleges in Western Australia. Students must reside in Perth;
2. Entries are open to all local film-makers residing in Perth;
3. Each short-film must be no longer than seven minutes long, including titles and credits;
4. Films must be in English or have English subtitles;
5. Works should be presented in VHS or DVD;
6. Entry is free of charge;
7. Short –films must include the Festival theme of Harmony:
Celebration of our culturally diverse society and mutual respect.
Unity in diversity by emphasizing common values and respect rather than differences;
Racial respect and community harmony
8. Due to the community nature of the Festival, films must not include nudity or coarse language;
9. Winners will be presented with prizes on Monday 19 March 2007 at the opening night function.
10. The first prize short-film will be screened at the opening night;
11. Entries must be postmarked on or before 3 February 2007;
12. One short –film entry only per film-maker;
13. Email entries won't be accepted;
